General description of incident

Active members provided potential new members the opportunity of standing in a pond, doing calisthenics in the adjacent field and buying a military style jacket. Potential members stood in a pond, did calisthenics and some bought jackets.

Violations of code of conduct

Findings of University or Court

Finding of responsibility for violation of the following policy(s):

- Hazing – new members stood in a pond and did calisthenics to become members
- Dishonesty – did not fill out a correct intake packet and not truthful in interviews with Investigator

Sanctions

- Disciplinary Probation beginning April 23, 2019 through May 12, 2022.
- No new member intake activities by be hosted off campus through May 12, 2022.
- Four Community Service projects per year (2 per semester) through the Center for Servant Leadership for two years through May 12, 2021 with a minimum of 75% participation rate.
- New member intake packet to be prepared with and approved by fraternity advisor through May 12, 2022.
